7. Photographs must not contain nudity, sexual content, violence, alcohol, drugs, tobacco, defamation of religious or ethnic symbols, hate speech, racial or otherwise inappropriate/offensive language or imagery.
8. Only entries uploaded on the UNICAF Facebook page will be accepted.

10. The deadline for entry is December 10th, 2016
